Boat Launch Rules

STAGING AREA – West side of Lakeview Dr in front of Marina

- Check watercraft essentials (Fuel, battery, plugs, etc.)
- All watercraft tie downs must be loose and removed for launch
- Confirm watercraft drivers for Launch
- Move vehicle/watercraft as traffic moves

LAUNCH AREA – Fire Pump Station and Boat launch

- Obey all Boat Launch Personnel Directions
- All watercraft passengers must be on watercraft
- Watercraft operator must be at wheel of watercraft
- Launch watercraft in assigned space
- Vehicle/trailer driver park only in approved parking spaces

RETRIEVAL AREA – Boat launch to West side of Lakeview Dr. in front of Marina

- Obey all Boat Launch Personnel Directions
- Confirm watercraft is staged in the boat launch area before loading
- Remove watercraft only from assigned space
- Vehicle operator to remain with vehicle during retrieval staging to keep the retrieval line moving

BOAT LAUNCH PERSONNEL – Please follow directions given by the boat launch personnel

- Don't bypass the staging area (unless instructed)
- Don't cut in line (unless instructed)
- FAILURE MAY RESULT IN LOSING YOUR PLACE IN LINE
